Helen Ketteman grew up small-town GA., where she developed a vivid imagination at an early age. Listening to the language of southern storytellers, she visualized strong images created by the words. She spent most of her time outdoors, soaking in myriad details – light filtered through trees and bouncing off water, the endless colors of shapes in nature, the textures of tree bark and rocks, the countless forms of life – insects, birds, plants, animals.

Her journey as a creative person began with books. She is the author of 27 published children’s books. Her books are known throughout the country and the world. They have been translated into Spanish, Portuguese, Japanese, and Chinese. She is an art quilter, and has exhibited in many quilt shows throughout Florida, including a recent show at the Captiva Community Center. Her entry at the West Palm Beach International Quilt Show won a blue ribbon for best use of embellishment.

She studied the process of oil and cold wax painting with nationally and internationally known artists Lisa Pressman and Lisa Broadwine. She studied acrylic painting with well-known local artist Theresa Girard. She exhibited paintings with the Sanibel Captiva Art League at Big Arts on Sanibel. Four of her paintings were juried into the exhibit at the soon-to-be opened Tribby Arts Center Gallery in Shell Point, and as a mixed-media artist, she is approved as a vendor at the Tribby Arts Center Gallery Shop.

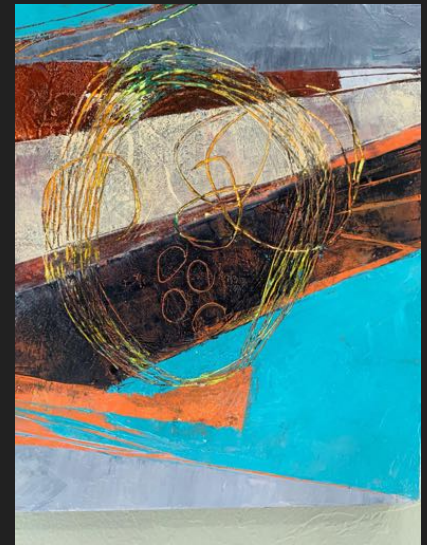

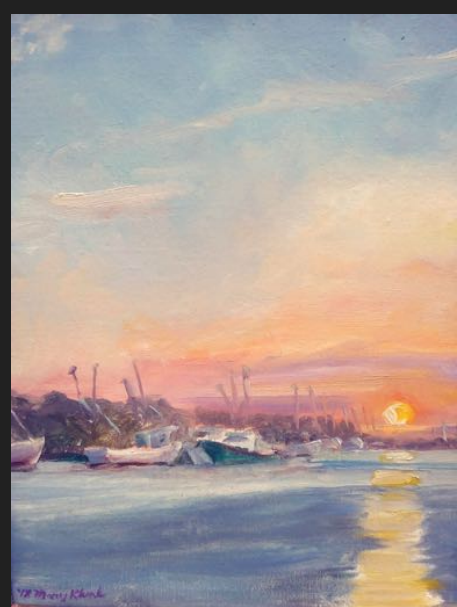

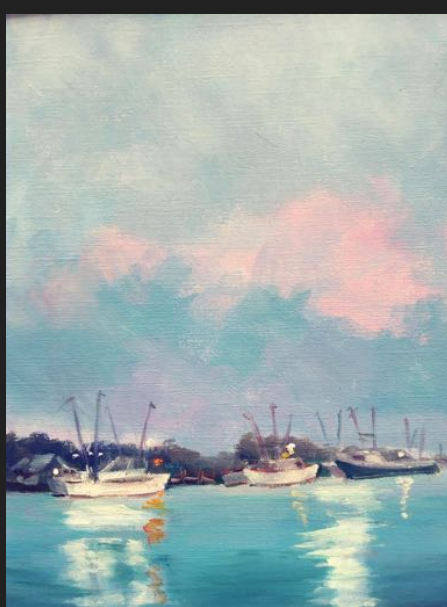

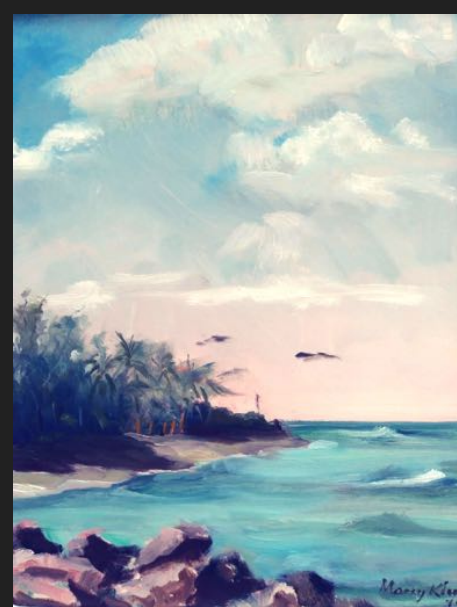
